

## Bibby Offshore vessels achieve 2.5 million man hours without LTI

Two of Bibby Offshore's dive support vessels achieved significant milestones this month. The DSV *Bibby Aquamarine* and DSV *Bibby Sapphire* completed one million man hours and one & half million man hours respectively without a lost time injury (LTI).
